WHEREAS, every year on Ride to Work Day, over a million workers commute via motorcycles and scooters to demonstrate the positive benefits of these efficient vehicles; and

WHEREAS, according to the United States Census Bureau and the U. S. Department of Transportation, over eighty million cars and light trucks are used for daily commuting on American roads, and only about 200,000 motorcycles and scooters are a regular part of this mix. On Ride to Work Day, the practical side of riding becomes more visible as a much larger number of America's 8,000,000 cycles are ridden to work.

WHEREAS, motorcycles and scooters consume less fuel and less parking space; and

WHEREAS, the City supports and encourages scooter transportation in the City and has established scooter and motorcycle parking sites.

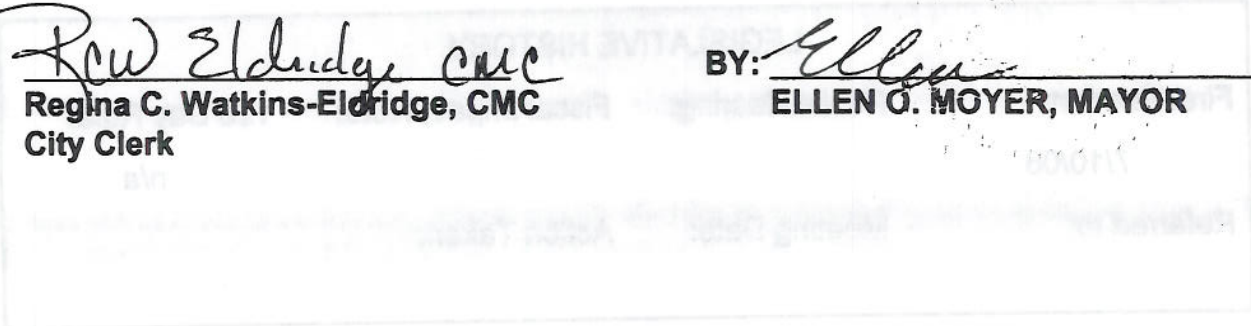
